The Wheat Quality Council held its Annual meeting remotely this year Feb 16-18, 2021. We had over 160 people for some of the sessions and feedback was good. We certainly missed being in person but accomplished our work in an efficient manner. The Zoom meetings technically went off without a hitch.

The Executive Board and Board of Trustees elected a new full slate of officers and members to guide the Council this year. They are all listed on our website. The council is in good financial condition and we welcomed three new members this year. Our two hard wheat technical boards met to discuss improvements and check varieties.
